Call for Nominations

The European Magnetism Association 2023 Dominique Givord Award for Advancing Magnetism in Europe

Established in 2019 by the European Magnetism Association (EMA), the Dominique Givord Award for Advancing Magnetism in Europe is awarded every three years, to an excellent scientist (or a group of maximum three scientists), who has significantly helped to push forward magnetism and the magnetism community in Europe.

The award consists of a certificate, a medal, a monetary award of €3,000, an invitation to the JEMS 2023 in Madrid to attend the award ceremony and present a plenary talk, and a travel allowance of €500 to that purpose.

The awardee will be selected by a committee composed of the members of the EMA General Council. Nominations may be made by anyone interested in the field of magnetism. Nominations for outstanding female candidates are encouraged.

Current members of the EMA General Council are ineligible to be nominated.

The nomination package should include:

- A completed nomination form, including a citation of no more than 25 words
- Curriculum vitae of the candidate, which must not exceed two pages in length
- List of 10 of the candidate's most significant publications, including citation information, not to exceed one page
- Commentary on the publications, which make the case for the award, not to exceed two pages
- Up to three letters of support, up to a maximum of two pages each

The documents must be collated into a single pdf file called *Surname_EMA-DGA.pdf*, where *Surname* is the candidate's last name. The file should not exceed 10MB in size. **Nominations not conforming to these rules cannot be accepted.**
