- Curriculum vitae of the candidate, not to exceed two pages.
- List of the candidate's ten most significant publications, including their numbers of citations
- Commentary on the publications justifying the award, not to exceed two pages.
- Three letters of support, which can include one from the nominator, limited to one page each.

The documents must be compiled into a single pdf file called *Surname\_EMA-DGA.pdf*, where *Surname* is the candidate's last name. The file should not exceed 10 MB in size.

## Nominations that do not comply with these rules will not be accepted.
