

Memorandum of Understanding



between the
European Magnetism Association (EMA)
and the
Magnetics Society



To encourage the exchange and dissemination of technical information, and to promote understanding and cooperation between the European Magnetism Association (EMA) (<https://magnetism.eu>) and the Magnetics Society (MSoc) (<https://magsoc.org/>), these organizations have agreed on the following matters:

1. GENERAL COOPERATION

- A. The MSoc Chair, Vice-chair or nominated committee member are invited to take part in a social meeting following the yearly meeting of the General Council of EMA, generally organized during an international conference on magnetism in Europe (typically JEMS, ICM or Intermag).
- B. The EMA President, Vice-president or nominated board member are invited to take part in a social meeting following the annual general meeting of MSoc.
- C. EMA and MSoc may share information about their major processes to coordinate actions and build-up their own experience. This may concern, e.g., guidelines for organizing events (program, practical, proceedings, hybrid format, diversity, carbon footprint ...).

2. TECHNICAL MEETINGS AND COLLABORATION

- A. Both EMA and MSoc have programs of diverse technical meetings and each can benefit from cooperative activities.
- B. Plans and schedules for international conferences and major events (e.g., schools, conferences, workshops) will be exchanged between EMA and MSoc.
- C. EMA and MSoc will seek to form partnerships for the co-support or co-sponsorship of international technical meetings when practical and in the best interests of both organizations to do so. Members of the boards or representatives of either societies can be invited to join the organization specific activities or initiatives to foster collaborations (e.g., conferences, event organization)

- D. Respective Coordinator(s) for the international relationships of the MSoc and EMA will be nominated by each society and will be the contact person for any matter.
- E. EMA and MSoc will seek to establish closer cooperation in activities oriented towards early career research and industry/academic relations.

3. COMMUNICATION

- A. EMA and MSoc include active links on their web site to (i) the web site of the other organization, as well as to (ii) the present Memorandum of Understanding.
- B. EMA and MSoc may send relevant messages to their own members or networks on behalf of the other, in compliance with their respective rules and constraints for dissemination and data protection regulations.
This concerns, for example, the reciprocal advertisement of JEMS, ESM, MMA, events that aid in broadening the magnetism community interests (workshops, seminars, surveys, trainings), as well as their awards campaigns and membership actions.

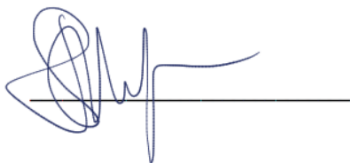
4. REVIEW, AMENDMENT AND TERMINATION

Amendments to the agreement may be proposed at any time but will not be valid until both EMA and MSoc have approved them.

This agreement is perpetual, yet subject to termination by any of the two parties on three months' notice in writing.

This agreement comes into force by the signatures of both parties on 11.06.2026.
